4. Sri Lanka Sustainable Development Bill : Order read for resuming adjourned debate on question (8th March 2017).

Question again proposed, and debate resumed, that the Bill be now read a second time.

The Minister of Sustainable Development and Wildlife and Minister of Buddhasasana moved,—That Hon. Mayantha Dissanayake do take the Chair.

Question put, and agreed to.

"(i) the Secretary to the President;"

"Provided however, in the event a matter pertaining to any Provincial Council is taken up for discussion at any meeting of the Council, the member nominated by such Provincial Council shall have the power to participate at such meeting.";

The Minister of Sustainable Development and Wildlife and Minister of Buddhasasana proposed another amendment to leave out line 25 in page 3 and substitute the following:-

The Minister of Sustainable Development and Wildlife and Minister of Buddhasasana proposed another amendment to leave out line 17 in page 7 and substitute the following:-

"mechanisms, audit mechanisms and all other matters relating;";

Clause 11

"Development shall be in force until the end of year 2030.";

The Minister of Sustainable Development and Wildlife and Minister of Buddhasasana proposed another amendment to leave out line 14 in page 8 and substitute the following:-

"Strategy on Sustainable Development to the President and the Minister. The Minister";

Ouestion that the amendment be agreed to, put, and agreed to.

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The Minister of Sustainable Development and Wildlife and Minister of Buddhasasana proposed another amendment to insert the following immediately after line 4 in page 9:-

" (8) The Minister shall co-ordinate with other project approving agencies for the purpose of implementing the National Policy and Strategy on Sustainable Development.";

Question that the amendment be agreed to, put, and agreed to.

Question that the Clause as amended stand part of the Bill, put and agreed to.

Clauses 12 to 28 were agreed to.
